Litany for Martin Luther King Jr. Birthday

Leader: Miriam hid a baby in the bullrushes, disobeying Pharoah's edict to kill the male children of the Hebrew slaves. The child grew to adulthood. Called by God, he liberated his people from Pharoah's bondage – and Miriam sang a freedom song!

People: Jonah, called by God to preach repentance to his enemies in Ninevah, resisted. He fled from Ninevah in a storm-tossed ship. Rescued from the depths of the sea, he returned to the enemy city, preached, and witnessed the Ninevites' salvation when they turned to God.

Leader: Mary, the mother of Jesus, accepted her call from God with rejoicing, saying "God has filled the hungry with good things and sent the rich away empty."

People: Paul, the apostle, journeyed over the known world founding Christian communities. Called by God, he preached reconciliation to Jew and Gentile, creating controversy among his colleagues as he pursued God's purpose of peace among estranged people.

Leader: Women marched together, carried banners, and demanded peace and justice. They sought peace among men and women and peace based on justice between races. Called by God, they struggled seventy years to win the right to vote in the United States so their granddaughters could take up the work they began.

People: Black and white marched together in Alabama, Mississippi, Chicago, and Washington DC, called by God to turn the nation around. Martin Luther King Jr was our drum major keeping rhythm as we walked toward a new day when liberty and justice would be shared by all.

Leader: The march continues as we raise our voices with all who are oppressed, violated, and rendered invisible because of gender-identity, sexual orientation, race, age, ability, or economic status. We are called to join with all creation crying out for a just peace.

People: Christ, our peace, we hear your call; we experience your ministry through the lives of peacemakers and justice seekers. Guide us as we follow the path of shalom. We thank you for the cloud of witnesses who have known your presence in their struggles every step of the way to peace. Your promise is sure that peace is possible when we follow the way you lead. Amen.
